Vide ref 3rd and 4th read above Government have ordered AP Electronics Policy 2014-20 for promotion of investments in Electronic Industries in the new state of Andhra Pradesh.

2. Vide ref 5th read above the Council of Ministers in cabinet committee have decided certain amendments and additions to the G.O.Ms.No.16, Information Technology & Communications (Promotions) Department, Dated: 09.09.2014. and G.O.Ms.No.7, Information Technology & Communications (Promotions) Department, Dated: 06.04.2015, in order to simplify the incentive administration, encourage employment and support new electronic industries as well to support expansion of existing electronic industries.
3. After careful examination, the Government have issued orders including amendments to AP Electronics Policy 2014-20 vide Go. Ms. No:16, IT&C (Promotions) Dept., dated 09-09-2014 and vide Go. Ms. No:7, IT&C (Promotions) Dept., dated 06-04-2015.

i) **Para 3A A1.(v) :**

Land Usage: Mixed purpose land usage will be allowed up to 20% of the land allotted for employee recreation / Housing.

ii) **Para 3A A1.(vi) a. :**

Project Timelines: Companies which are allotted land shall follow the timelines as mentioned below:

- Start construction within 180 days
- Employment fulfillment in 3 years - 30%
- Employment fulfillment in 5 years - 70%
- Employment fulfillment in 6 years - 100%

iii) **Para 3A A1.(vi) b.:**

APIIC can take back allotted land on pro-rata basis in case of non-compliance of timelines or any other unfulfilled conditions.

iv) **Para3.A.A2.(ix)**

Training companies: Training Companies are eligible for investment subsidy of 50% or Rs. 1 Crore, whichever is lower.
