ORDER:

Institute for Electronic Governance (IEG), Hyderabad established vide 2nd reference cited above listed under Schedule – X of the A.P. Reorganization Act, 2014 is offering its services to more than 200 colleges and 20,000 students in the state of Andhra Pradesh. Its activities mainly dealing with Campus Training Programs to Engineering, MCA, MBA and Degree students through Industry Academia Collaborations, Faculty development / enablement programs in collaboration with industry partners, Campus placement assistance to Engineering, MCA, MBA and Degree students, Capacity Building of Government employees on Tablet PCs and Digital Literacy, Deploying manpower to various government departments for website application / maintenance etc.

2. After bifurcation of the State, to promote the interest of the public, Government has issued circular memo vide 1st reference cited above and the Government of Andhra Pradesh has recognized the need for the establishment of “Andhra Pradesh Information Technology Academy (APITA)” in place of Institute for Electronic Governance, Hyderabad a Schedule-X Institution of A.P. Reorganization Act, 2014 with new objectives and focus.

3. The registered office of the society shall be situated in the state of Andhra Pradesh in Vijayawada and the Society shall provide a range of capacity building services in Information Technology domain with the following main objectives.

- i. To support the Capacity Building initiatives of Information Technology, Electronics and Communications Department through a wide range of activities such as building abilities, relationships and values that will enable organizations, groups and individuals to improve their performance and achieve their objectives.
- ii. To develop and offer courses of varying duration in or related Information Technology, Electronics and Communications, that may lead to certificates, diplomas or degrees. This may be done jointly with Industry, Universities or any other Institution.
- iii. To provide a conducive environment for learning through value additions programs.
- iv. To promote the Industry – Academia interaction and empower the students living in rural areas through IT literacy and appropriate skills so as to bridge the Urban rural divide and produce readily employable graduates.

- v. To catalyze among the student community and especially among students of technical education, a culture of research and development and close involvement with the design and implementation of technology solutions for various real life problems, through, but not limited to mechanisms like Student Knowledge Forums.
 - vi. To undertake on its own and/or in collaboration with other educational and research institutions, and with industry, research for the promotion and development of Electronic Governance.
 - vii. To facilitate e-governance through oriented programs for state government employees and conduct awareness programs for enhancing the public awareness on IT, Electronics and Computing.
 - viii. To offer consultancy support in Capacity Building Programs and depute personnel to Government as well as other public or private organizations on any aspect related to Capacity Building.
 - ix. To offer consultancy support on projects related to Capacity Building in Information Technology, Electronics and Communications towards attainment of Knowledge Society.
 - x. To collect, analyze, collate, tabulate, disseminate and circulate data, statistics, information etc. relating to or connected with any discipline of Information Technology, Electronics and Communications.
 - xi. To monitor, advice, develop and train the stake holders on the requirements with respect to any of the areas of Information Technology, Electronics and Communications.
 - xii. To promote the development of more strategic, systematic, and measurable approaches to Capacity Building at all levels.
4. To fulfill the objectives, the society promotes to establish “Amaravathi Knowledge Centers” in Engineering / Degree / PG Colleges.
